High School Math School Supply List

Pencils
Notebooks or Loose-leaf paper (3 to 4 notebooks)
1 ½ to 2 inch three-ring binder (Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1, Precalculus, Calculus)
2 to 2 1/2 inch three-ring binder (Geometry, and Algebra II)
Binder rings must be round, straight/ slanted ones will not work
5 section dividers for the three-ring binder (post-it tabs, flags, etc will work or actual tab divider packages)
Calculator (Scientific calculator recommended for Pre-Algebra to Geometry - TI-30XS Multiview is used in the classroom, Graphing calculator recommended for Algebra II and above - Texas instruments brand TI-82 to TI-86 is fine. Other brands and models can be purchased, and graphing calculators are available on a first come basis for yearly rental/ check out. I would not recommended a graphing calculator that is not texas instruments brand, and the TI-83 and TI-84 are the best models to look for.
