

Winter School District Supply Lists 2020-2021

4 Year Old Kindergarten:

- 1 hard plastic pencil box/case, hinged (not a pouch or a box in a sleeve) (please label)
- 1 box washable markers (please label)
- 2 boxes of 8+ crayons (please label)
- 1 watercolor set
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 container antibacterial wipes
- 1 box gallon size zip top bags (not stand and fill)
- 1 Kinder mat (please label)
- 1 reusable shatter-proof water bottle (please label)
- 1 full size backpack (backpacks marketed to preschoolers are too small)

Clothing (please label):

- [Now] Velcro or slip-on sneaker/gym shoes *It is not required in 4K that your child leave a separate pair of gym shoes at school, but we will be using the gym so your child will need to either bring or wear shoes appropriate for running.
- [Later] Snow pants or bibs, a winter coat, insulated winter boots, winter hat, waterproof/insulated gloves
- Optional: rain boots, mittens, mitten/glove clips (highly recommended)

*Please keep a seasonally appropriate full change of clothes, including socks, in a zip top bag inside the backpack at all times.

Kindergarten:

- A pack of pencils
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of markers (washable please)
- 2-Glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white glue (Elmer's works best)
- 2 folders with pockets (for sending home notes)
- 1 pair of gym shoes (to leave at school)
- Pencil box or case
- Blunt tipped scissors
- 1 box of Kleenex to share
- Water Bottle for self (reusable is best)
- Book bag (normal size please-the small ones do not fit books or folders)

Extras that would help tremendously, but are not mandatory:

- 1 container of wet wipes
- Plain paper plates
- Gallon Ziploc bags
- Small Ziploc bags
- 1 container of sanitizer wipes

First Grade:

- LOTS of pencils
- Pencil box/case
- Crayons
- Colored pencils
- 1 glue bottle (Elmer's...not gel or fancy glue)
- scissors (Fiskars brand works the best)
- 2 folders
- 1 large box of Kleenex (classroom size)
- 1 box of Ziploc type bags (sandwich, quart or gallon size)
- Backpack/book bag
- Water bottle
- Tennis shoes - to stay in the building for Phy Ed and recess

Second Grade Supply List:

- Good quality pencils (such as Ticonderoga) to be replenished as necessary
 - Erasers - both pencil top and regular to be replenished as necessary
 - 24-pack of crayons
 - 10-pack markers
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - Supply Box
 - Two heavy duty folders (one to bring papers back and forth and one to use at school)
 - Tissues - a large box or two to share
 - One box ziploc type bags - If your last name begins with A-L please bring quart or sandwich size. If your last name begins with M-Z please send gallon size.
 - Tennis Shoes - to be kept at school for Phy. Ed
- *Optional, but greatly appreciated - sanitation/ antibacterial cleaning wipes and/or paper plates

Third Grade:

- Pencils : A plentiful supply of Ticonderoga would truly be best...and please be ready to replace as needed.
- Pencil Top Erasers...we go through these quickly also!
- 2 wide-lined spiral notebooks
- Crayons or markers/colored pencils (Your choice)
- Scissors (Fiskars are great!)
- Two glue sticks
- 1 or 2 red or blue pens for occasional use
- One heavy duty pocket folder to carry papers to and from school.
- Shoes for phy. ed.
- A large box of tissue to share with the class
- 1 box Ziploc type bags (If your last name begins with A-L, please bring quart sized. If your last name begins with M-Z, please send gallon sized.
- "Earbuds" for use with our classroom computers and a container to keep them in.
- A refillable water bottle Water fountains will not be in use due to COVID restrictions.
- Optional add-ons if you would like to donate a classroom item: cleaning wipes and or/paper plates
