School District of Winter Approves \$4 Million April Referendum

Winter, Wis. (December 19, 2019) – The School District of Winter’s Board of Education passed a resolution at its December meeting to pursue a \$4 million referendum in the April 7, 2020 election. As part of the District’s 2018 strategic plan, a third-party agency was hired to conduct a facility audit. This evaluation found upgrades were needed to the building’s foundation, roof, windows, hardscapes, and flooring, among other things.

The School District of Winter assembled a Facilities Advisory Committee to review and prioritize the identified needs. After careful review, the committee was able to determine a scope of work that would fit the District’s mission of cultivating high standards while respecting the community’s budget.

The School District of Winter’s last building referendum was in 1996 for additions and renovations to the K-12 facility. The District recently made the final bond payment on this previous debt, allowing there to be no tax impact of approving this question.

“The Board of Education has done a good job keeping the community at the forefront throughout this process,” said Andrew Grimm, District Administrator. “We plan to maintain the same level of respect moving forward.”
